Hiking – week in the mountains of ‚Sierra de Tramuntana’ Mallorca

The Dry-stone Route (GR 221) is a long-distance path of 140km, which runs from Andratx in the south-west of the island to Pollença in the north. A range to discover the built-in dry-stone landscapes in the Tramuntana mountain range as well as other dry-stone features - such as retaining walls, walls, dry-stone fountains, shelters, snow houses, amazing landscapes, orange- and olive fields etc. Additionally the route goes through interesting historic remains. Hikers will learn about traditions, customs, gastronomy, craft work, etc.

The path runs mainly on old bridle ways that wind very close to the higher peaks of the mountain range, which are mostly over 1,000 m high. At the end of each stage the hiker will stay in a refuge located in a restored house. We will enjoy the part from Deià to Pollença...

The second part of this hiking week offers a variation of the most spectacular tours in the mountains of the ‚Sierra de Tramuntana’, with stay in typical fincas or nice hotels in the surrounding of Pollença – one of the most beautiful places in the North of the Tramuntana.

Day 1: Pick-up from the airport, Deià, Stay in Refuge Can Boi

Depending of the arrival-time it is possible to do an easy, varied tour...



Day 2: Hiking from Deià to Tossals Verds, Stay in Refuge Tossals Verds

The most beautiful places of this stage are probably the valley of Sóller and Cuber, and the Gorge de Barranc Biniaraix. Orange groves, olive groves, manors, country houses, irrigation systems (wells, washing areas, canals, wells, water mills) make this stage to the one with the richest contrasts of the program. In the heart of the Tramuntana - incredible views of the reservoirs and the 'Puig Mayor' (1411m).



Day 3: Hiking to Lluch, Stay in Refuge Son Amer

One of the most bizarre and most interesting tours in Mallorca. One is constantly amazed at the beautiful rock formations that are millions of years caused by erosion in the rock. All this - surrounded by an ancient oak forest - is a mystical combination of stone and tree. You will be surprised by the - we call it - 'Gothic architecture of nature'.



Day 4: Hiking to Pollençà, Stay in the area of Pollençà

By Lluch, we reach across the old pilgrim route the target of the long distance trail. An old cart path leads up from the valley to the mountain passes Pelat Coll and Coll of Pedregaret. Quite quickly we will reach the Coll de Menut. From this pass it goes all downhill to the finish in Pollençà.

Part II – Sierra de Tramuntana



Day 5: Hiking Puig Tomir (1.104m), Stay in the area of Pollençà

A spectacular trip to one of the peaks of Mallorca. First broad, then narrow forest paths over stony ways and rocks uphill to get to the Puig Tomir (1.104m). 450 meters almost permanently up hill - offering incredible views of the entire Sierra de Tramuntana, the island's interior and on the north coast. In the southeast the capital Palma is amazing to see, also the indulging views of the Puig Major (1446m).



Day 5: Hiking Torrent de Pareis, Stay in the area of Pollençà

The Torrent de Pareis is the second largest canyon in the Mediterranean. A few hundred meters towering cliffs, unspoilt nature and total silence make the tour a fascinating experience. The crossing of the canyon is not a hike in the classical sense: many times we must be climbing over rocks that would be impassable in the opposite direction. And where it is not possible to walk anymore, you have to slide down a rock sometimes... Amazing!!!



Day 7: Hiking Mortitx, special-dinner, Stay in the area of Pollençà

This hiking tour doesn't bring you to any mountain top - but to the incomparable wilderness of the north coast of the island. We walk through neglected areas, nature in its purest form. This hike is one of the undiscovered places, Mallorca has to offer. Bizarre rock formations, narrow paths, a beautiful torrent with some adventurous climbing sections. An adventure hike that you for sure will never forget.
