



SPRING HIKING 2017

1. ALCANADA – S'ILLOT. A WILD BOTANIC GARDEN.

On the peninsula of Alcúdia is one of the most interesting excursions connecting the Bays of Alcúdia and Pollença, passing through the "cami de ses fontenellas" (the fountains path) This is a very interesting route due to its large variety of landscape, including two totally different coasts, those of Alcúdia and Pollença, leafy pine groves and winding paths with a wide variety of plants and vegetations. During the tour we pass around the Alcúdia Watchtower 444mts, which seems to be watching us all the time. It is an easy stone route. We finish in S'Illot, a surprising pleasant cove in the Bay of Pollença. 9 km
Medium linear excursión.



2. POLLENÇA – LLUC MONASTERY (S. XIII) THE PATH OF THE PILGRIMS.

As from the thirteenth century pilgrims departed from several points of Mallorca making the journey to the sacred Lluc monastery praying for blessings from the virgin of Lluc, (The Black Madonna) one of these trails began in Pollença. This path is linear in large part passing through beautiful oak groves. It begins in the Son Marc valley 5km from Pollença and ends at the monastery, passing through Pixerells, one of the most interesting areas of the island for its fantastic rock formations from the Karst period. Once in Lluc, you can visit the beautiful Basilica and its spectacular surroundings.

Linear excursion easy but long, 14km. Good footwear is recommended.



3. SERRA DE CALICANT. AN UNKNOWN MALLORCA TO DISCOVER.

At the southern end of the Serra de Levante is the small interesting Serra de Calicant mountain range, near San Llorenç, a little known area preserving a very particular nature and impressive views over the entire eastern part of the island. It is an excursion with many contrasts. The first part is 4 km of rural road surrounded by beautiful farms



leading on to an almost magical world of goats paths winding through a valley that seems drawn from prehistory, the views from the 371mts peak are 360° of spectacular panoramas. The last 3km is an easy mountain track. Medium 10km linear excursion with easy road except the peak climb that is medium.



4. FORMENTOR – CALA FIGUERA – FORMENTOR BEACH. LEGENDS AND GLAMOR.

The Formentor peninsular, made famous by The hotel Formentor always very popular with the glamorous and famous jetsetters of the 1950s, along with its dense forests filling the area with legends and histories.

The path from the beach to Cala Figueras is an easy and entertaining walk passing through dense vegetation. A great place to enjoy our picnic is at the wild area of Cala Figuera, which has a mystic feeling, and rest on its pebble beach. The short returning path has natural steps due to erosion. Easy 8km tour. You can use sport shoes, but mountain footwear is recommended.



5. SA DUAIA – CALA TORTA – SA DUAIA. CALAS, VALLEYS AND CORSAIRS.

The peninsula of Levante, is geology the oldest area of Mallorca and specifically the valley of Sa Duaia. This excursion offers a surprise with every step due to its wild beauty amongst a variety of landscapes valleys, hills, forests and the coast, the area was once visited by The Corsairs. We enjoy a picnic in the spectacular Cove of Cala Torta where we can relax before entering the last stretch of our route, a winding road that passes through a stream running between the hills that lead us into a very interesting world of sedimentary rock formations.

Circular tour of medium level of 12km with easy paths except for about 2km in which there is not an evident path, but can be passed without to much difficulty.



6. COVES BLANQUES – CALA SANT VICENÇ. EARTH OF IMPONENTS CLIFFS.

Cala Sant Vicenç is in the municipality of Pollença, here you will find one of the most beautiful paths of the Serra de Tramuntana, "Pas d'Es Pescadors" (the fishermen path), which was used by the fishermen of Cala Sant Vicenç to reach Cala Castell. To reach the path you pass by the white caves, an unfinished bunker on some impressive cliffs. The whole excursion is of a rare beauty because of the aridity and its cliffs, with beautiful panorama over the north of Majorca and the peninsula of Formentor. The first part of the tour is uphill with no concrete path giving a touch of adventure but can be



followed easily; the rest of the route is descending by an easy road going to C. S.Vicente. Linear medium 10km excursion it is recommended to wear very good footwear

7. BINIAMAR – MANCOR – BINIAMAR. AN AUTHENTIC AND PURE MALLORCA.

Some parts of Mallorca have managed to keep their authentic essence, with small quaint villages and hidden unspoilt landscapes. This excursion takes us to one of these parts of the Island, where we find beautiful valleys with centuries old olive, almond and carob trees, all within a peaceful and tranquil area of the Island with splendid views over the central plains. At the end of the route we visit a typical Mallorcan town where we can enjoy a coffee in the pretty village square of Biniamar.

An 13 km easy route with nature and a wide variety of landscapes.



8. RANDA – MONASTERY OF CURA 538M. THE MOUNTAIN OF THE THREE MONASTERIES.

Average 9 km circular excursion. We leave Randa following 1½ km road and then onto a goat's path to the Cura monastery 330m. Once at the top we discover the monastery and Ramon Llull's world, one of the most influential and important people of Mallorca's history. After a picnic with breathtaking views of the Island, we take a coffee and descend on the other side, passing by the monasteries of Sant Honorat and Gracia, to finish in Randa.



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
